The Executive Director: Public Interest Disclosure, Systemic Investigations and Prevention Initiatives directs a multi-disciplinary team of managers and professionals to implement provincial public interest disclosure legislation, oversees systemic investigations, and develops prevention and culture change initiatives for public authorities to ensure practices are administratively fair. The Executive Director also provides expert advice to the Ombudsperson, the Deputy Ombudsperson, co-ordinated with other senior staff, and ensures an aligned approach across the three teams.

### Qualifications:

This position will be of interest to applicants who can demonstrate the required qualifications, including a university degree in a related discipline and at least 10 years of investigative experience in statutory compliance, public sector oversight, or other public administration capacities, and a minimum of 5 years of progressively more responsible experience in public sector management roles.

If you are interested in meaningful work that makes a difference in people's lives, submit your application to join our office as the Executive Director of Public Interest Disclosure, Systemic Investigations and Prevention Initiatives.

An eligibility list may be established to fill similar future vacancies in a temporary or permanent capacity. Some travel is required. Salary will be commensurate with education and experience.

Your application must clearly identify how your education and experience meets the position requirements. You must identify which positions you are relying upon to meet the criteria of investigative experience and how the position meets that criteria. In describing your education and experience, please pay particular attention to the position description including the competencies and selection criteria.

As part of the screening process, your application may be used to assess your written communication skills.
