

## Public Interest Disclosure Act: Annual Report for Columbia Basin Trust



The *Public Interest Disclosure Act* (PIDA) is whistleblowing legislation that came into force for Columbia Basin Trust (the Trust) on December 1, 2022. As such, the Trust must report on all disclosures of wrongdoing that have been made under PIDA in respect of the Trust.
