

Public Interest Disclosure Act: Annual Report for ETSI-BC

Fiscal Year FY2025

The Public Interest Disclosure Act (PIDA) came into effect for the Southern Development Initiative Trust (DBA ETSI-BC, the Economic Trust of the Southern Interior) as of December 1, 2022.

PIDA is BC's whistleblower protection legislation that is intended to help employees in the public sector (including those employed by 'public bodies' such as ETSI-BC) to speak up about wrongdoing in the workplace and to provide a safe and confidential process for doing so.
